Statement by Dr. Nan Hayworth regarding Congressman John Hall's reelection announcement:

"The economy is broken and John Hall helped break it. Returning John Hall to Washington is going to lead to more job-killing taxes, more bureaucracy and more nationalization of the economy. We need to renew our economy and grow jobs and that's going to take new leadership."
