Strong showing by Hayworth in 2nd-quarter filing

The Nan Hayworth campaign today reported cash on hand of almost \$775,000 as of the end of the second quarter, a sum that puts Dr. Hayworth in an excellent position in her challenge to Congressman John Hall in New York's 19th District.

Dr. Hayworth reported contributions of more than \$219,000 in the quarter, according to the campaign's Federal Election Commission filing Thursday. For the campaign to date, total contributions surpass \$737,000. Notably, the campaign's cash-on-hand figure has increased significantly in each quarter, from \$519,007 at the end of the year to \$658,594 at the end of March, and now to \$774,985 at the end of June.

"I'm thrilled by the continued strong support of our backers, our volunteers and people all across the district who agree that the 19th can be a centerpiece of turning back the tax-and-spend agenda that John Hall supports," Dr. Hayworth said. "We are building exceptional momentum with a fast-moving campaign and the right ideas. Voters are realizing that John Hall is more in sync with Nancy Pelosi than with the 19th. I will fight for the policies we need to create jobs, grow our private economy and rein in federal spending."

Dr. Hayworth loaned the campaign \$100,000 during the period (this figure is separate from the contributions listed above). The campaign received \$16,500 in PAC money during the period, making the total PAC contributions during the election cycle so far \$43,500. The campaign reported total operating expenses during the period of \$203,632. Additionally, the campaign has had strong fund-raising momentum since the filing period ended, with roughly \$65,000 received in early July.

"This campaign is moving extremely rapidly," campaign manager John Hicks said Friday. "It's significant that Dr. Hayworth continues to outpace John Hall in fundraising, and I think it shows a real desire for new representation in Washington."
